Power vessel underway, not making way



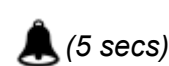
Last vessel of tow, if manned



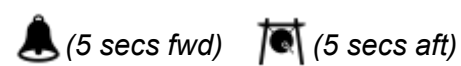

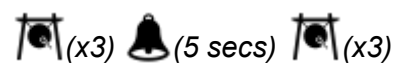
Vessel at anchor
